The Greatest Mansion on Earth

It's not the kind of property you often come across for sale in the city: 24 rooms (including 12 bedrooms), a fully windowed attic, a solarium, a front porch, and an extra large backyard are just a few of its highlights. But the 1880s medieval-style mansion of famed Barnum & Bailey Circus entrepreneur James Bailey is not your typical home. "This mansion is one of New York's architectural residential treasures," says Lori Huler Glick, vice president at the Stribling and Associates, which is listing the property at \$6.5 million. The interiors were designed by Joseph Burr Tiffany, a cousin of Louis Comfort Tiffany, and dramatic touches include a staircase that flanks a 12-foot mercury mirror. The home is located at 10 St. Nicholas Place in Harlem and is close to spectacular views of Yankee Stadium and Jackie Robinson Park. For more info: stribling.com.
