Stribling Associates held an open house for the Bailey mansion at 10 St. Nicholas Place, the fabulous 1880s Victorian mansion of **James Bailey**, a partner of PT Barnum in the Barnum & Bailey circus. The property is a prominent icon in the heart of the culture-rich Harlem community of Sugar Hill, just steps away from Yankee Stadium as well as Jackie Robinson Park.

The limestone mansion was designated a city landmark in 1973. It's been owned since 1951 by **Marguerite Blake**. Interiors were by **Joseph Burr Tiffany**, a cousin of **Louis Comfort Tiffany** and they feature extensive window installations by master craftsman **Henry F. Belcher**. The double height entry features French polished oak floors and crafted mahogany inlay with a dramatic staircase that flanks a 12 mercury mirror, offering an elegant entry experience.
